

Charles Sturt University Ceremonial Flags - Order Protocol

Charles Sturt University ceremonial flagpoles consist of five flags. The Australian National Flag takes precedence over all other flags when it is flown in company with other flags. The below instructions are in accordance with Australian Flag Protocol. Contact the University Secretary for guidance on the order of precedence for ceremonial flagpoles with less than five poles.

* The NSW flag is to be flown at campuses located in NSW. The ACT flag is to be flown at campuses located in the ACT.
