

## **Emergency Planning Committee Key Performance Indicators**

## 1. Planning

- 1.1. Emergency Planning Committee (EPC)
  - 1.1.1. EPC meetings: 4 quorate meetings held per year
  - 1.1.2. EPC membership: 100% positions filled and > 75% member attendance.
  - 1.1.3. EPC Risk Register: Reviewed quarterly in line with CSU policy.
- 1.2. Campus based Critical Incident Response Groups (CIRGs)
  - 1.2.1. Campus CIRGs meetings: 4 quorate meetings per year.
  - 1.2.2. Campus CIRGs membership: 100% positions filled.

## 2. Preparedness

- 2.1. Emergency Management website: Reviewed annually. All documents, information and links reviewed and current.
- 2.2. Building Evacuation Diagrams: 100% of buildings with a current evacuation diagram installed.
- 2.3. Buildings with a current emergency plan: 100% of staff occupied buildings requiring an Emergency Plan.
- 2.4. Building Trial Evacuation/ Emergency response exercise annually: 100% of buildings that are required to have annual evacuation.
- 2.5. CSU Safe registrations: 20%, calculated per campus, of on-campus student and staff headcount.
- 2.6. Training 'Fire & Emergency Procedures' online module: 100% of CSU staff complete every 2 years.
- 2.7. Training 'Emergency warden training' face to face training: 100% of emergency wardens attend every 2 years.
- 2.8. Training for EPC and CIRG members: 100% of members attend one training or skill retention activity conducted per annum.

## 3. Response

- 3.1. Campus based Critical Incident Response Groups (CIRGs): Reporting Number of Critical incidents responded to AND 100% of Critical incident documented debriefs held.
- 3.2. CSU Safe 'Urgent' Requests: 100% of 'Genuine' Urgent requests responded to.
