

## **Appendix 2 - Naming Schema for Roads, Walkways and Paths**

### **1. Roads**

Roads will generally be named in the Indigenous language of the area, for Indigenous place names or Indigenous nations. The names should be clear and pronounceable.

### **2. Walkways and Paths**

Paths and Walkways will generally be given names that recognise and celebrate:

- (a) important historic figures in the development of the campus region. Appropriate historic figures may include: significant contributors to the intellectual, cultural, scientific, political and sporting life of the region; political or military leaders, who were born in, lived in or are strongly connected with the region in which the campus is located; explorers and pioneers or
- (b) rural and regional Australian leaders who were born in, or have a strong connection to, a campus town or region – in which case the name should recognise only deceased individuals whose reputation has stood the test of time and who represent rural and regional innovation, creativity, determination and capacity throughout our history.
