



Emergency Management Schedule – Example emergency events

Emergency events and scenarios that may require enactment of an emergency management plan include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Human caused emergencies
 - a. Arson
 - b. Bomb threat
 - c. Building invasion/armed intrusion/active shooter
 - d. Civil disorder
 - e. Medical emergency
 - f. Personal threat
 - g. Self-harm
 - h. Suspect object/mail/package
2. Natural
 - a. Fire/smoke (including grass fire, bush fire, etc)
 - b. Extreme weather (including severe storm, flooding)
 - c. Earthquake/tsunami
 - d. Explosion
 - e. Flood
 - f. Severe weather/storm damage
 - g. Animal attack/incident
3. Technological
 - a. Asbestos exposure
 - b. Chemical, biological and radiological incidents
 - c. Transport or aviation incident
 - d. Confined space incidents
 - e. Hazardous material incidents
 - f. Industrial incidents
 - g. Structural instability
