

University Course Planning Committee - Membership and Terms of Reference

Section 1 - Establishment

- (1) Established by the Vice-Chancellor on 13 August 2002.
- (2) The University Course Planning Committee is a committee of the Vice-Chancellor with responsibility for determining the course profile of the University and for providing advice on the development of external partnerships in support of the course profile.

Section 2 - Membership

- (3) The University Course Planning Committee (UCPC) shall comprise:
 - a. Vice-Chancellor (Presiding Officer);
 - b. Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic)
 - c. Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Administration)
 - d. Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Research, Development and Industry)
 - e. Presiding Officer, Academic Senate
 - f. Executive Deans
 - g. Executive Director, Division of Library Services
 - h. Executive Director, Division of Information Technology
 - i. Executive Director, Division of Facilities Management
 - j. Executive Director, Division of Student Administration
 - k. Executive Director, Division of Student Services
 - I. Executive Director, Division of Marketing and Communication
 - m. Director, Centre for Enhancing Learning and Teaching
 - n. Director, Planning and Audit

Section 3 - Terms of Reference

- (4) The University Course Planning Committee shall:
 - a. determine the the University's course profile, including additions or phase-out of courses, and variations to location, funding source, mode, type of offering (i.e. session or trimester based) or Faculty ownership of a course and any other variations (including phase-out of a specialisation, major or minor) that have resourcing implications;
 - b. approve the the University's strategic plan for the development of its course profile;
 - c. review the implementation of the the University's strategic plan for its course profile;
 - d. consider and provide advice on proposals for external partnerships, new campuses and alternative modes of

delivery from the point of view of the course profile; and e. have the responsibility to refer to the Vice-Chancellor and the Budget Committee matters for which budget, equipment and capital works requirements, as they relate to the course profile, cannot be addressed within normal operating budget.
