

## **Schedule 1 – Exclusions and limited support for Elite Athletes, Elite Sports Personnel, Elite Performers and Pre-elite Athletes**

### ***Category 1 - Courses excluded from provisions of the Elite Athlete Policy***

The following courses have been excluded from the Elite Athlete Policy as the nature of the course does not allow for deferral, extension, exemptions and other academic support normally available to elite athletes:

- **Associate Degree in Policing Practice (ADPP)**
- **Engineering Courses**

### ***Category 2 - Courses with limited flexibility within provisions of the Elite Athlete Policy***

- **Bachelor of Veterinary Biology/Bachelor of Veterinary Science** has specific entry requirements, the completion of the Elite Athlete Special Consideration Application (SCA) needs to be completed in conjunction with the Vet application process. This course will take the Elite Athlete SCA into consideration during the application process. This course has limited flexibility for enrolled students, flexibility request considered on a case by case basis.
- **Bachelor of Pharmacy and Bachelor of Clinical Practice (Paramedic)** courses have significantly reduced flexibility due to compulsory attendance in some subjects at, in some cases, weekly practical classes.
- **Bachelor of Exercise and Sport Science** undergraduate courses are currently on-campus with reduced flexibility due to compulsory attendance in some subjects at which have laboratory classes.
- **Bachelor of Health Science (Mental Health)** must attend residential schools to complete accreditation requirements.
- **Bachelor of Nursing** students will be supported where possible within the limits of accreditation requirements. Bachelor of Nursing students seeking support should contact their course director to discuss.
- **Nurse Practitioner** students will be supported where possible within the limits of accreditation requirements. These students need to negotiate with their employers as accreditation is linked to work arrangements.
- **Graduate Diploma of Midwifery** students will be supported where possible within the limits of accreditation requirements. Those seeking support should contact the Course Lead to discuss. Student midwives will also need to negotiate leave with their employers, as the course is structured to facilitate *concurrent* theory and practice requirements.
- **Masters of Speech Pathology** limited flexibility in consultation with the Head of School.
- **Dentistry and Oral Health** limited flexibility.
- **Bachelors of Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Podiatric Medicine, Speech and Language Pathology** have students will be supported where possible within the limits of workplace learning requirements.
- **Bachelor of Social Work & Master of Social Work (Professional Qualifying)** must attend residential schools to satisfy accreditation requirements.

## Schedule 2 - Residence Life support for Elite Athletes, Elite Sports Personnel, Elite Performers and Pre-elite Athletes

Students granted elite or pre elite athlete, elite sports personnel or elite performer status may be eligible for support by Residence Life. Awarding of scholarships and other support will be based on merit within a finite budget available for such support at the discretion of Residence Life. The level of support available may vary depending on whether students are classified as elite, pre elite or sports personnel. As per clause 42 (Part C) of the Elite Athlete Policy, students granted support by Residence Life may be required to work with the Division of Marketing and Communication for promotional purposes. Students should apply to Residence Life to be considered for the following support options.
