Minor works, programmed works and maintenance works	Building maintenance, cleaning, repairs, various trade or technical work and minor modifications, audio visual repairs, cabling etc	Yes	Yes	Yes
Major Works	Construction works valued over \$250,000 and/or where a principal contractor or contractor has been appointed to manage the works within a defined area under their control.	As defined by Contract	As defined by Contract	As defined by Contract
