

Senior Executive Committee and Planning and Strategy Committee - Membership and Terms of Reference

Section 1 - Membership

- (1) The Senior Executive Committee (SEC) is comprised of:
 - a. Vice-Chancellor (Chair);
 - b. Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic);
 - c. Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Administration);
 - d. Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Research, Development and Industry);
 - e. Chief Financial Officer: and
 - f. Executive Director, Human Resources.
- (2) The Planning and Strategy Group (PSG) is comprised of:
 - a. the members of the SEC;
 - b. Director, Governance and Corporate Affairs;
 - c. Director, Strategy Coordination; and
 - d. Director, Planning and Audit.
- (3) The Vice-Chancellor may invite other officers of the University to attend meetings of the committees.

Section 2 - Terms of Reference

Part A - Senior Executive Committee (SEC)

- (4) The SEC meets weekly to share information, brief each other and seek advice, as appropriate, on current or imminent activities and issues, and to provide advice to the Vice-Chancellor on:
 - a. major matters requiring approval by the Vice-Chancellor;
 - b. actions arising from the University Council and senior management committees of the the University;
 - c. establishing, monitoring and maintaining delegations;
 - d. approval of the University-wide policies;
 - e. strategic issues arising between meetings of the Planning and Strategy Group;
 - f. management of major change; and
 - g. other matters referred to the Committee by the Vice-Chancellor.

Part B - Planning and Strategy Group (PSG)

- (5) The PSG meets monthly and provides advice to the Vice-Chancellor on:
 - a. the framework and direction for the planning and management of the the University;
 - b. the performance of the the University against the the University Strategy and Plans;
 - c. key strategic opportunities and initiatives, including major infrastructure developments and funding applications (e.g. EIF, HHF);
 - d. development and review of the annual operating budget of the the University;
 - e. development, integration and monitoring of the the University Plans;
 - f. development and monitoring of the Operational Plans of Faculty, Divisions and Schools; and
 - g. other matters referred to the Committee by the Vice-Chancellor.

Section 3 - Operating Principles for the Committees

- (6) Within the model of "One the University" the committees are committed to:
 - a. consultation;
 - b. collaboration within the Committees;
 - c. communication across the the University;
 - d. representation of all Primary Cost Centres; and
 - e. recognition of Conflict of Interest members of the Committee shall notify other members of any "personal interest" in a matter that relates to the affairs of the Committee.

Section 4 - Meeting Schedules

- (7) Throughout the year the Vice-Chancellor may convene formal meetings or retreats of the SEC/PSG to discuss and advise on strategic matters, which include, but are not limited to:
 - a. development of annual budgets;
 - b. educational profiles;
 - c. strategic planning, including the three the University Plans and the Operational Plans;
 - d. performance indicators relating to the the University Strategy 2007-2011 and the three the University Plans;
 - e. quality programs; and
 - f. performance management.

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
